SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTION LEADER POSITION (Fall 2010)

Supplemental Instruction (SI) is an academic support program utilizing peer-led study sessions to assist students in Basic Math (MAT 087) and Accelerated Algebra (MAT 095) with their coursework.

SI Leader responsibilities include:

- Facilitating 2 SI sessions each week using collaborative and active learning strategies
- Attending the mathematics class assigned to you
- Taking notes on the material covered in class
- Attending required SI training (March 23rd & 24th)
- Promoting the SI program campus-wide
- Attending monthly staff meetings
- Additional administrative functions as required

(\$11.50 per hour, 10
hours per week, for
15 weeks)

Student **MUST** meet **ALL** of the qualifications listed below:

- Must be enrolled at RCC in the fall 2010 semester (Both part-time and full-time students are eligible!)
- Must have a 3.5 or higher G.P.A. in all college-level mathematics courses taken
- Must have an overall G.P.A. of 3.5 at RCC
- Must have recommendation from a RCC math instructor
- Must be able to attend all SI meetings and training sessions
- Must be willing and able to attend all scheduled class meeting for your assigned course
- Must be able to plan and facilitate two SI sessions per week
- Must be friendly and enjoy working with other students
- Applications are available in Room 207 Academic Building

NOTE: June 2010 graduates are not eligible for this opportunity.
