at Roxbury Community College**

Boston—The Roxbury Repertory Theatre Company proudly announces its upcoming production of *The Miracle Worker* at Roxbury Community College.

Based on William Gibson’s classic American drama, *The Miracle Worker* is the inspiring true story of Helen Keller and her teacher, Anne Sullivan. Struck in infancy by a crippling illness that left her blind and deaf, young Helen’s main means of communication were furious tantrums. It was Anne Sullivan, a young teacher losing her own eyesight, who helped Helen break the barrier of her dark, silent existence.

Helen is played by 10-year-old actress, Elise Hana, and Anne Sullivan is played by RRT veteran, Julie Dapper. Deaf Actress Whitney Meyer and Nora O’Riley, who is fluent in sign language, round out the diverse cast.

Director Marshall Hughes notes that, “While we are using the core company in the production, we cast a wide net.” Hughes added, “And the reward is a challenging ensemble that works hard at getting the message of the piece right and truthfully told. It makes for a very focused and creative ensemble of cohesive actors because of their collective abilities and disabilities.”
