**Department of Corporate and Community Education to Hold Graduation**

Fourteen students will receive certificates when they graduate from a Phlebotomy Technology program at Roxbury Community College on Wednesday, June 24, 2009.

The Phlebotomy Technology program is sponsored through Roxbury Community College's Department of Corporate and Community Education. The graduation ceremony will be held in the Dance Studio at RCC, which is located in Room 301 in the Media Arts Building, 1234 Columbus Avenue, Roxbury.

The event begins with refreshments at 4:30 P.M. followed by graduation.

The Phlebotomy Technology program is part of an ongoing community education program, which began in March, 2008. The program offers 10 weeks of skills training, followed by a 120-hour internship at a local hospital or health clinic. The program also offers job readiness training, computer skills, and help finding suitable employment.

New programs for 2009-2010 will include Customer Service, Social and Human Services Assistant, accelerated E.S.O.L., and Certified Nursing Assistant.

All of the students in the current program come from Roxbury, Dorchester, Mattapan, and Hyde Park.
