Radiology Technology Program
Summary of Cost of the Program

To ensure a high quality experience for students choosing to enter into the field of radiology technology Roxbury Community College strives to provide the best learning environment with the supports students will need to successfully pass the radiology licensure exam. To cover the costs of providing this program course specific fees have been developed to ensure that RCC has the resources it needs to continue to provide a high quality program.

Base Instructional costs for all credit courses:

Tuition	Covers direct instructional salaries. The tuition is set by the Massachusetts Department of Education	\$26 per credit
Campus Fee	Covers the cost of maintaining the College campus, cost of information technology, library, athletics, Student support center, copy center, and administrative functions of the College	\$185 per credit
Student Activity Fee	Covers the cost of providing student activities, graduation costs, student government, and other non-academic services to students	\$50 per semester

Radiology Technology Program:

The additional costs required specific to the radiology program includes but is not limited to maintaining a radiology laboratory, JCERT program certification costs, professional liability insurance for all faculty and staff, MSRT membership for faculty and students, exam preparation software and tools, immunization tracking system, clinical tracking system, supplies, conferences and professional development.

The total per student cost over two years for the radiology program comes to \$1,800. While many colleges will require students to pay this total cost upfront at time of enrollment, RCC allocates the cost over the period of the program. The upfront entrance fee of \$600 covers the cost of enrolling students in the systems used to track their progress through the program. The remaining cost of \$1,200 is allocated over the six radiology courses required to complete the program as follows:

- TEAS V for Allied Health: \$94.00
- CPR: \$30.00 to \$100.00
- Immunizations: Fees vary depending on the immunizations needed and the student's insurance

During Program of Study

- Health Insurance: Costs vary depending on the insurance company and coverage selected
- Books: \$1,000.00 to \$1,200.00

Fees After Graduation:

- National/State Examination Fees: ARRT: \$200.00
- State License application and State Licensing Fee: \$75.00 + \$150.00 for a total of \$225.00
