<u>Assignments</u>: Analyze and employ a variety of critical thinking skills in oral and written assignments, in-class debates and presentations.

Assessment: Rubrics for writing and oral presentation

<u>Assignments</u>: Utilize campus resources to learn, communicate with instructor and peers, complete assignments, research academic topics, and library instruction.
